ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

PART 1 GENERAL

1.1 Receipt of Bids

- A. Sealed proposals will be received by the Kishwaukee Water Reclamation District for the project entitled “2019 Spot Repair Project – Kishwaukee Water Reclamation District, DeKalb, Illinois” until 11:00 AM on Tuesday, September 3rd, 2019 at the Office of the Kishwaukee Water Reclamation District, 1301 Sycamore Road, DeKalb, Illinois 60115. The sealed bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the District Office at 11:00 AM, on the same date. Sealed bids shall be addressed to the Kishwaukee Water Reclamation District, 1301 Sycamore Road, DeKalb, Illinois 60115 and shall be labeled “Bid for 2019 Spot Repair Project – Kishwaukee Water Reclamation District.”
- B. Bidders will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246, as amended. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in 41 CFR 60–4.

1.2 Work Description

- A. The proposed improvement consists primarily of the following:

Installation of approximately 180 LF of 8” PVC sanitary sewer, with sanitary manhole and sanitary service connections, as well as sanitary manhole frame and lid replacements at 5 locations, with concrete collars.

Contract Documents must be obtained from Tracy Zenkner to be on the plan holders list. Addenda will be issued only to plan holders.

1.4 Bonds

- A. Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid bond, bank draft, cashier's check or certified check payable to the order of the Kishwaukee Water Reclamation District, DeKalb, Illinois, in an amount not less than ten (10) percent of the amount of the bid, as a guaranty that the bidder will execute the contract, if it is awarded, in conformity with the bid form.
- B. The successful bidder will be required to furnish Performance and Payment Bonds on forms provided in the Specifications and Contract Documents, each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price.

1.5 Wage Rates

- A. Prevailing Wage Rates as defined by the Illinois Department of Labor for DeKalb County shall apply to this contract. Rates can be obtained online at <https://www2.illinois.gov/idol/Pages/default.aspx>.
- B. Prior to submitting his bid, the Contractor shall ensure that the wage rates used in arriving at his bid correspond to the current wage rates in effect. If these rates are revised by the Illinois Department of Labor during the duration of the contract, the revised rates shall apply to the contract.

1.6 Rejection of Bids

- A. The Owner expressly reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to accept the bid, which appears to be in the best interest of the Owner. The Owner expressly reserves the right to waive any informalities or technical irregularities in a bid if to do so is in the best interest of the Owner.
